This is a contract between the parties of Farmers Supply LLC and The Lodge at Mt. Rushmore water system has 2 wells and 20000 gallon cistern.


The purpose of this contract is to comply with the Certification Law by contracting with an operator that is not a direct employee of the system. This contract is necessary to fulfill the need for a certified water operator for the site.

The following is a list of obligations that will be met by the certified operator:

1. Visit the water system on-site on a weekly basis.
2. Keep a residual of 0.3 mg/l of chlorine.
3. Be in direct charge of treatment and maintenance of the water system that includes two wells and one 20,000 gallon cistern with a pellet dropper chlorinators.
4. Assist in completing all tests to comply with the state and DENR requirements.
5. All required repairs would be performed on a time and material basis.

The parties agree that for the above listed routine services an amount of \$456.00 per month will be paid by the 10th of each month.

This contract is a binding contract to commence on June 1, 2015 through November 30, 2015 when the camp is operational.

Proposal for "Contract Water System Operator" Wild Turkey Estates HOA, Spearfish, SD

Purpose:

- Provide contract services as a South Dakota Certified Water Distribution Operator for Wild Turkey Estates, Spearfish, South Dakota.

Duties of Contractor:

- Responsible for both water systems' treatment and distribution system operations and maintenance, maintaining efficient system operation and maintenance (on-going and preventative);
- Perform timely water sampling and chlorine residual measurements for each water system maintaining chlorine levels of at least 0.5 to 1.0 parts per million free chlorine residual in all areas of the distribution system;
- Collect and submit all water system samples and maintain sampling and testing records for both water systems in compliance with state and federal regulations;
- Make on-site visits to well locations weekly, to inspect and/or adjust well pumps, storage tanks, chlorine levels, chlorination system operation and automatic controls;
- Exercise all hydrants and valves on a regular basis;
- Keep operational, maintenance and administrative records of all water system activities;
- Provide reports, status updates, complaints or water quality and quantity issues to the HOA Board as directed;
- Analyze operational data to determine changes and improvement for more efficient operation;
- Maintain contact information for vendors necessary to resolve water system issues in case of emergency or repair needs.
- Work directly with EPA and South Dakota DENR during inspections or any other matters that pertain to water testing and system operation for the Wild Turkey HOA.
- Maintain required South Dakota Water Operator Certification while this contract is in effect.

\$550 (\$275 per system) payable on the 1st of each month.

- Treatment chemicals and supplies
- Laboratory testing fees
- State and local taxes







 - b. Two years of postsecondary education in a qualifying discipline, and 18 months of qualifying experience as a Grade 2 operator or the equivalent of a Grade 2 operator in another jurisdiction; or
 - c. A bachelor's degree in a qualifying discipline and one year of qualifying experience.
 4. For Grade 4, at least:
 - a. High school graduation or the equivalent and three years of qualifying experience, including one year as a Grade 3 operator or the equivalent of a Grade 3 operator in another jurisdiction;
 - b. Two years of postsecondary education in a qualifying discipline and 30 months of qualifying experience, including one year as a Grade 3 operator or the equivalent of a Grade 3 operator in another jurisdiction; or
 - c. A bachelor's degree in a qualifying discipline, and two years of qualifying experience.




