**Gov. Daugaard Announces \$1.55 Million Loan  
for Canton Drinking Water Improvements**

PIERRE, S.D. – Gov. Dennis Daugaard says the state Board of Water and Natural Resources has approved a \$1.55 million Drinking Water State Revolving Fund loan to Canton for improvements to the city’s drinking water source.

The loan will be administered through the Department of Environment and Natural Resources.

“I am pleased to announce that Canton will receive this assistance,” said Gov. Daugaard. “This funding will help the city make necessary improvements to meet its existing and future drinking water needs.”

The project involves installing two wells to replace existing wells that no longer perform as needed and replacing and upgrading outdated high service pumps and controls.

The estimated cost of the improvements is \$1.97 million. Loan terms are 3 percent for 30 years.

The Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Program provides low-interest loans for public drinking water system projects.

The board met Thursday and Friday in Pierre.
