Gov. Dugaard Announces \$528,000 for Dimock Wastewater Project

PIERRE, S.D. – Gov. Dennis Dugaard says the state Board of Water and Natural Resources approved a \$528,000 funding package to Dimock for wastewater collection system improvements.

The funding package includes a \$478,000 Clean Water State Revolving Fund loan and \$50,000 water quality grant. Loan terms are 3.25 percent for 30 years.

The funds will be administered through the Department of Environment and Natural Resources.

“I am pleased to announce that Dimock will receive this assistance,” said Gov. Dugaard. “This funding will help the town make much-needed wastewater system improvements to better serve its customers.”

The project involves reconfiguring the town’s existing bi-level cell into a total retention wetland facility; replacing the main interceptor line and support structure at the crossing over Twelve Mile Creek; and extending sewer lines to a proposed 20-home development.

The estimated cost of the project is \$568,000.

The State of South Dakota and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency fund the Clean Water State Revolving Fund Program, which provides low-interest loans for wastewater, storm water and nonpoint source projects.

The board met today over the Digital Dakota Network.
