**Gov. Daugaard Announces \$559,000 Loan  
for Mina Lake Sanitary District Wastewater Project**

PIERRE, S.D. – Gov. Dennis Daugaard says the state Board of Water and Natural Resources approved a \$559,000 Clean Water State Revolving Fund Program loan for Mina Lake Sanitary District to make wastewater system improvements.

The funds will be administered through the Department of Environment and Natural Resources.

“I am pleased to announce that Mina Lake Sanitary District will receive this assistance,” said Gov. Daugaard. “This funding will help the district make needed wastewater system improvements to better serve its customers.”

The Mina Lake Sanitary District proposes to remove the dike between cell #1 and #2, construct an artificial wetland, make additional treatment cell improvements and replace the pumps in the main lift station with submersible pumps.

The estimated cost of the project is \$579,000. Loan terms are 3.25 percent for 30 years.

The State of South Dakota and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency fund the Clean Water State Revolving Fund Program, which provides low-interest loans for wastewater, storm water and nonpoint source projects.

The board met today in Pierre.
